ENTRY PICK UP:

- Entries must be picked up at main exhibit building. (Dome building- parking lot entrance)
- **All entries must be picked up on:**
 - Monday, May 6, 2024, 4:00PM-7:00PM
- The exhibitor or representative must present claim ticket to reclaim entries.
- If participant is not able to pick up entry on above date, it is the participant's responsibility to schedule alternative date or time with SB Fair & Expo Exhibit Coordinator.
- SB fair is not responsible for unclaimed entries.

SWEEPSTAKES/TOP EXHIBITOR:

- Sweepstakes will be awarded to the exhibitor scoring the highest number of points per category as per point system.
 - A total of 25 points must be achieved by at least three (3) exhibitors for Sweepstakes to be awards in each category.
 - An exhibitor must have a minimum of 10 points to qualify.
 - First Award, 5 Points
 - Second Award, 3 Points
 - Third Award, 1 Point
 - Exhibitor *cannot* win 1st place in consecutive years.
 - All categories, with the exception of Arrangements & Cut Flowers, qualify to enter into sweepstakes.
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ADULT EXHIBIT GENERAL RULES:

- Participants/Exhibitors must be 18 years or older.
 - All exhibitors must be amateurs unless otherwise stated.
 - An amateur is defined as any individual *not* earning more than 50% of their income from entered division/craft.
 - Exhibitors do not have to be a resident of Santa Barbara County to enter.
 - All entries must be delivered to the main exhibit building on assigned date and time. **No late entries will be accepted.**
 - All entries must be prepared within two years prior to the opening of the fair; April 2022-April 2024. **Exception:** Homemade beer & wine must be prepared within four years prior to the opening of fair; April 2020-April 2024.
 - Participant's name must clearly labeled be on the **back or bottom** of all entries.
 - All entries must be made exclusively by the exhibitor.
 - Exhibitors must hereby agree to that their name, city and photograph may be used for fair publicity.
 - The SB Fair & Expo management shall not be responsible for accidents or losses that may occur to any of the participants or entries exhibited. The participants/ exhibitors shall hold the management harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident or loss.
 - All entries will follow additional "Division Rules: under specific Division heading in catalogue.
 - Exhibitors must adhere to all SB fair rules.
